

Students Medal in Niagara

Meadowvale's ACE Taekwondo Academy won 12 medals at the Niagara Open Championships, held Saturday in St. Catharines.

Jennifer Li, 10, was named the club's most valuable competitor after winning double gold in green belt sparring and forms. Youssef Salib, 12, and Nikhil Sarin, 13, also won sparring gold medals.

Hank Bae, 11, won a pair of silver medals in blue belt sparring and forms. Brandon Ngo, 9, won silver in sparring and bronze in forms.

Other silver medalists were Zubair Othman, 9, and Karim Salib, 13, both in sparring. Harry Guo and Ethan Zhang, both 9, rounded out the medal haul with a bronze apiece in sparring.

Sachin Sarin, 9, placed fourth in forms.

ACE Taekwondo was the only Mississauga club at the event, which drew some 400 athletes from across North America.
