

## ACE Taekwondo Wins Big In Toronto

ACE Taekwondo students continue to dominate at tournaments.

The Meadowvale-based school sent 22 athletes to the Toronto Open last weekend (Nov. 13-14), and came away with 22 medals — nine gold, eight silver and five bronze.

Other multiple medalists were Kaitlyn Bryan, 10 (sparring gold, forms bronze), Jayson Bacolod, 10 (silver medals in sparring and forms), Jennifer Li, 11 (sparring silver, forms bronze), Hankyeol Bae, 12 (forms gold, sparring silver) and Maggy Youakim, 44 (forms gold and sparring silver).

Themba Dube, 6 (forms gold), Alejandro Budahazy, 7 (sparring silver), Brandon Ngo, 10, and Zubair Othman, 10 (both sparring bronze), Daniel Philistin, 12 (forms silver), Darian MacLean, 12 (sparring bronze), Nikhil Sarin, 13 (sparring gold) and Neha Sarin, 42 (forms silver) racked up individual medals.

The biggest event on the Ontario Taekwondo Association calendar also featured athletes from Mexico, Dominican Republic, Asia, the United States and other countries.
